- Awarding Gap: Alice (overview by SK)
  - UCB has 4<sup>th</sup> worst Black Award Gap
  - AY shared University plan to tackle this
  - Uni/Guild want to create a combined aim, and question 'what that aim' could be
  - o Decision:
    - Relay information regarding success and ensure this is measurable
    - Point 25 highlight the purpose of ANY ambassador before roles are actioned. E.g. School BAME ambassadors.
  - o Action(s):
