6	The Events and Marketing Society submitted their budget and the executive amended to
	reduce the cost of the day trip to £750 and remove the funding for a finale party. The
	executive suggested that if the group want to collaborate with other Course Based
	Societies for an end of year socials, they should submit development funding. The
	executive approved £1450 for the society.
